

Reviewing Your Budget

How to read your budget, track spending, and know what is available.



Summary: Your budget is what determines how much you can spend every month. We know how important it is for you to have information on your spending, so MyLynk is set up to show it to you.

WHERE TO FIND YOUR BUDGET

- Log in to MyLynk to see your current budget information, including what has been spent and what remains available.
- You'll also receive a monthly statement that provides a detailed summary of your spending for that period.

WHAT'S IN YOUR BUDGET

- Your budget reflects the services and supports included in your approved VDC plan.
- Direct Care Worker pay - Your budget includes the approved funds available to pay your Direct Care Worker(s) based on their approved rate and hours worked.
- Goods and services - If your plan includes approved goods and services, your budget will also show the funds available for eligible purchases from approved vendors.

STAYING ON TOP OF YOUR SPENDING

- Keeping an eye on your budget can help you make informed decisions about your care and avoid surprises.
- Check your MyLynk dashboard regularly to see how your spending is tracking.
